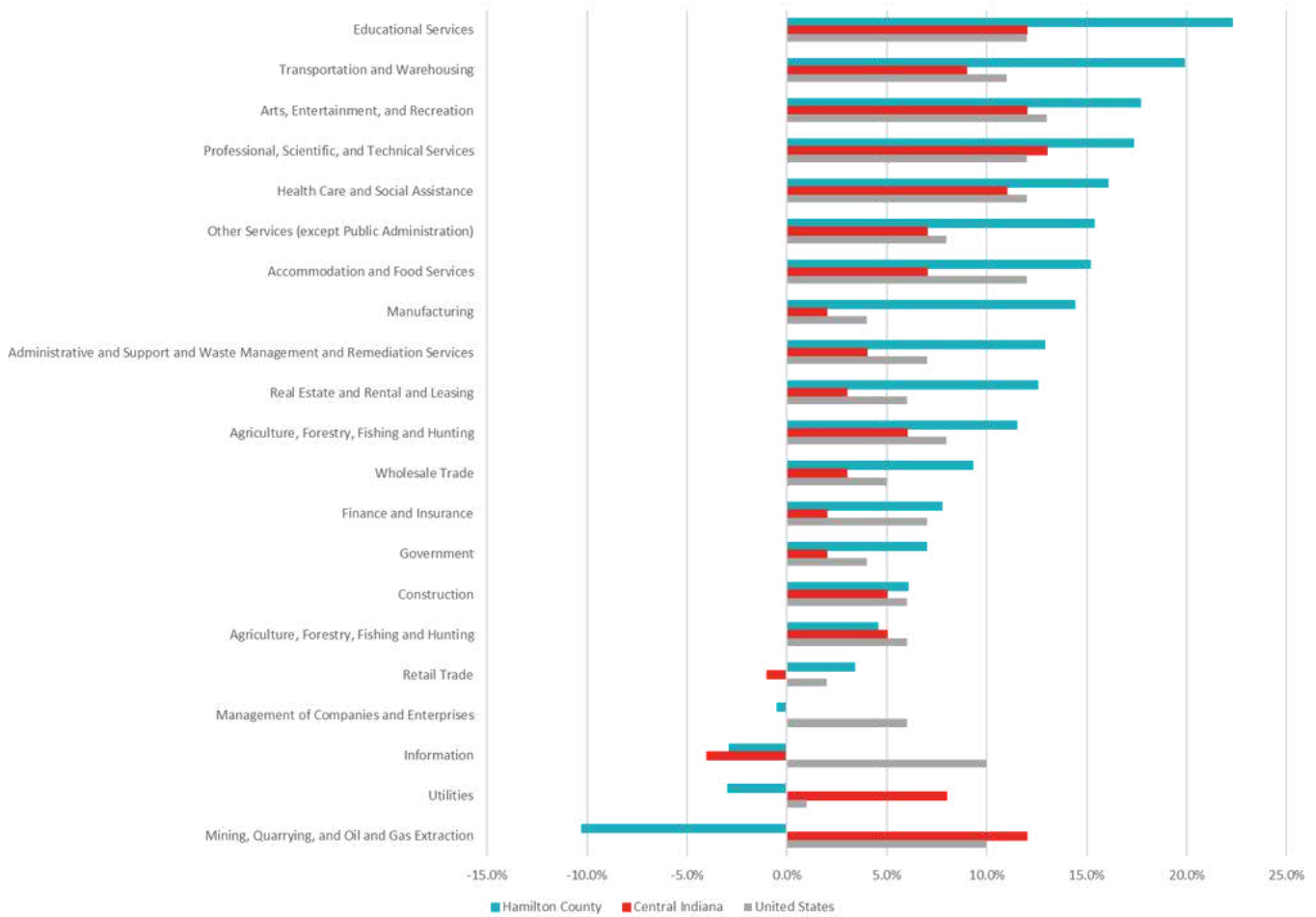


JOB GROWTH COMPARISON

Description: This chart illustrates forecasted job change from 2023 to 2030 across all industry sectors at the 2-digit NAICS code level. The 2-digit NAICS level is the highest classification for industry sectors and includes all subsectors, industry groups, and industries. Percent change is compared for Hamilton County, Central Indiana, and the United States. This data is sourced from Lightcast’s second quarter 2023 data run.

Hamilton County generally exhibits higher employment growth rates across a wide range of industries compared to both Central Indiana and the United States. Hamilton County consistently outperforms both Central Indiana and the national average in several sectors. **Educational Services, Transportation and Warehousing, Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation, and Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services exhibit substantial growth in Hamilton County, well above the corresponding rates in Central Indiana and the United States.** This trend is also evident in Other Services, Accommodation and Food Services, Manufacturing, and Administrative and Support Services. However, a few industries, like Management of Companies and Enterprises, Information, and Utilities, show declines or slower growth in Hamilton County. Overall, Hamilton County demonstrates a robust employment landscape across diverse sectors, contributing to its strong economic position compared to regional and national areas of comparison.
